Project Description:

MiHC is seeking an expert consultant to refine and improve training materials and curriculum used by our team of College Success Coaches. MiHC's College Success Coaches are an integral part of MiHC's La Próxima Generación (Prox Gen) program. Prox Gen is a culturally relevant, two-generation program that supports Hispanic students and parents as they navigate college access and persistence.

The consultant will evaluate and improve all training materials and curriculum for the College Success Coaches. The consultant will also develop a new, improved training plan for College Success Coaches.

MiHC's standard of excellence mandates that we partner with content experts that are recognized as leaders in their field. We also hope that those we hire are committed to our mission and have values that align with our organization's work.
