We help Michigan first-generation & low-income students and young professionals navigate the complexity of college access through early career by providing support, resources, and opportunities. To strengthen Michigan's economy through MiHC scholar's bachelor's degree attainment and career success.

#### What We Do

At MiHC, we take a holistic approach to student success. Our programming is designed to support first-generation youth at every step of their academic and professional journey:

- College Readiness & Access: Workshops, coaching, and resources to help students navigate college applications, financial aid, and scholarships.
- College Persistence: Ongoing support for students enrolled in college, including success coaching, peer networks, and connections to on-campus resources.
- Career Readiness: Internships, mentorship, and professional development programs that build pathways from college to career.
- Family Engagement: Bilingual programming and culturally relevant guidance to empower families as active participants in their students' educational journey.
